Union Wins BIG Raises at FairVote

Members who work for FairVote Minnesota just ratified a contract with significant wins even after poor gains during the legislative session. Among other wins, base pays increase by 5-6.8%, existing staff will get an additional 4-5% pay bump each year of the contract, and employer has agreed to a 1-1.5% 403b match for longevity employees.



PUBLIC NEWS SERVICE CELEBRATING FIRST GUILD CONTRACT

Faced with growing workloads and high turnover due to burnout, workers at Public News Service started organizing in 2021.

In June, the 22 journalists and staffers represented by the Minnesota Newspaper & Communications Guild approved their first contract, a two-year deal poised to make a big difference in work-life balance.

"Some of our big wins are a raise for just about every employee and a path for sustainable wage growth – and a system of ensuring a 40-hour workweek," said Jake Sinderbrand, partnership and outreach manager at PNS who was involved in negotiations.

"We didn't get everything we wanted, but we got enough to make our work lives a lot better over the long term."

Public News Service is a nationwide network of state-based news services founded in 1996 to provide outlets free access to otherwise under-reported news in the public interest.

As such, the union push was a virtual effort – from early organizing to the 13 months of negotiations – since staffers are spread across the country.

"What's notable is how everyone in the union came together for meetings late at night or after bargaining sessions, repeatedly, to make sure everyone had their input on the contract," Sinderbrand said.

Management voluntarily recognized the union last year after 100% of workers signed cards, but it took a change in ownership to seal the contract deal this spring, Sinderbrand said. Plus a little help from the Guild.

"We worked with Candace Lund throughout the process, she is just an amazing force, patient and detail-oriented, helping us through every piece of this," he said. "We were so grateful to be able to work with her."
